Ex: *"His name broke and he signed 'Yo' to walk away."*
3. stage. d. g. b. Place of the mask, celebration of the lie.  
Ex: *"To decorate Nothingness, David sculpted a Yo."*

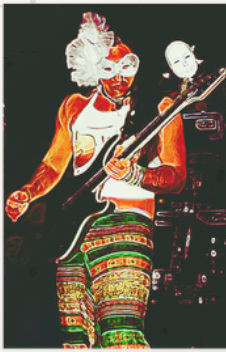

My grandmother always told how, when she was young, she sang so well that 'the people from the radio' wanted to make her a star. They even had her stage name ready: Carmina Alegría.

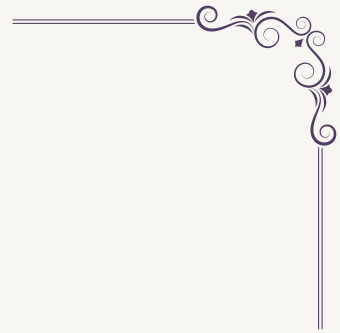
Life had other plans, and my grandmother always kept 'what could have been'... until today.

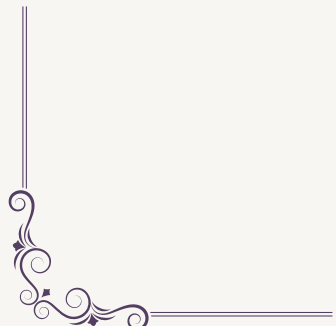
